Deadline: **Monday, October 24, 2011**

The Louisiana Trust for Historic Preservation (LTHP) needs your direct help in identifying historic structures within Louisiana that needs preserving. Nominations are being accepted for candidate sites which are threatened by demolition, neglect, lack of maintenance, inappropriate development or other threats and meet the Louisiana Trust's criteria. Structures selected on LTHP's "Most Endangered" list receive assistance from the LTHP Preservation Field Services Representative with on-site visits and working with the property owner and community leaders in creating a preservation strategy for the structure. No limit to the number of structures nominated. Criteria for consideration:

Structure is historically significant (at least 50 years old) and significantly threatened as fully described with an attached explanatory paragraph.

Demonstrated community commitment and reasonable potential for a positive outcome.

Clear ownership of the property and owner / owners willing to work with the LTHP Field Services Representative in creating a viable plan for preservation.

Structure is listed or potential of being listed on an appropriate national or state historic register.

Complete and return Site Information (page 2) and Release Authorization / Owner Consent (page 3) and include an explanatory paragraph on the property; short history / biography of the structure and "then" and "now" pictures. All submissions are to be forwarded to LTHP in digital / electronic format attached to an email.
